Each year, the Los Angeles Bible Training School and its Alumni Association cosponsor the evening's activities. The banquet has a history of being a special time for everyone who attends. But this year was truly unique. The evening was devoted to giving glory to God by paying tribute to Dr. Alonzo E. Levert.

The festivities began with the congregational singing of "To God be the Glory" and "Lord I Lift Your Name On High". After the welcome and prayer by the Master of Ceremony, Pastor Robert Scott of the Los Angeles Community Bible Church, there was a time of eating and a renewing of ac-

LABTS Announces Spring 2003 Semester


Ten classes have been announced for the upcoming Spring 2003 semester at Los Angeles Bible Training School. The Monday morning day class will be Revelation II taught by Paul Felix. Day classes meet from 10:15 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. and evening classes from 7:00 p.m. to 9:20 p.m.

The dates for registration are January 13 and 16, from 6:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. The semester begins on January 20 and ends on May 15. No tuition is charged for the classes. There is a registration fee of \$30.00 that will allow a student to take a maximum of four classes per semester.
