You get what you pay for! That adage is certainly not true for the students at LABTS. They pay \$50.00 per semester and receive much more than that from a faculty which has been well-prepared to teach these students the wonderful word of God. Each of the faculty members, except one, has earned a college degree. Every member of the faculty has a Masters degree. Two have earned a Masters of Art (M.A.), another has been awarded a Masters of Ministry (M.Min.), nine have received a Masters of Divinity (M.Div.), and one will graduate with his M.Div. in May. The Masters of Theology (Th.M.) has been earned by five different teachers. Six of the men who currently teach have an earned doctorate, either a Doctor of Theology (ThD) or a Doctor of Philosophy (PhD).


More importantly, the LABTS Faculty is serving the Church and Christian schools of


