

The year 2012 has brought about the home-going of some dear saints of God who were very special to me in my service as president. The Chancellor of LABTS, Dr. Alonzo Levert, entered into the presence of the Lord Jesus Christ on January 28. He faithfully served God for over 36 years as the second president of LABTS. At his home-going service I noted that Brother Levert was a spiritual mentor for me who modeled three things. First, he modeled sacrificial service. Second, he provided a pattern for faithfulness to God. Third, this servant of God set before me the example of loving LABTS. Anyone who knew Dr. Levert was convinced that he loved the school.

On July 8, Professor Calvin Sills began to enjoy the blessings of being face-to-face with the Lord Jesus Christ. It can be said about the one who was known as "Mr. Wonderful" that he is truly wonderful since he is in heaven. Pastor Sills graduated from LABTS in 1968 and began to teach at his Alma Mater in 1987. He taught for 25 consecutive years until the Lord called him home. During the course of those 25 years, he taught at least 50 courses. Although Professor Sills was a faithful and dedicated teacher, he was primarily known for his passion for evangelism and missions. He was committed to the Great Commission (Matt 28:19-20).

The majority of the readers of this newsletter are unfamiliar with Pastor L. Dwight Custis, who was received into glory on July 11. God, in His providence, brought this man into my life through his grandson, Will Custis, who was a student in my Greek Exegesis I and II classes at The Master's Seminary. In 2005, Pastor Custis invited me to speak at the annual Bible Conference of Trinity Bible Church in Portland. Thus, a special relationship was established with Pastor Custis and the fine people of Trinity Bible Church. Among churches, Trinity Bible has risen to the top in her consistent generosity to LABTS. I am grateful to God for the godly example and love of Pastor Custis and his faithful exposition of the Word of God.

I will miss these men, but I am comforted by the truth that "to die is gain" (Phil. 1:21b). These men are beholding the very face of Christ!
