Facts on the 2015 **Graduation Class**

- There were 18 graduates (10 men and 8 women)
- The shortest time it took a student to graduate was 3 1/2 years and the longest time was 18 1/2 years
- The youngest graduate was 25 years old and the oldest was 82 years old
- The average age of the graduation class was 53 1/2 years old
- This was the first graduating class where the non-African American students were the majority
