### LABTS NEWS

Student Richard Ray Carpenter, Jr., went home to be with the Lord on July 1, 2016. The celebration of his life and legacy was on July 15 at his home church, the Mt. Tabor Missionary Baptist Church, where former LABTS graduate Dr. Ticey Brown serves as pastor. Brother Carpenter was one class short of graduation. He first began the school in the Fall of 2008.





Dr. Whalen S. Jones, father of Marlean Felix was called to glory on July 13 at the age of 107. It was Dr. Jones who urged President Felix to attend LABTS at the age of 21. The home-going service for the former pastor of Messiah Baptist Church (which he founded in 1954) was held on July 23. At the age of 99, Dr. Jones was the 2009 LABTS Commencement speaker.

Former LABTS student Allyson Felix made her fourth consecutive USA Olympic Team. She won the Olympic Trials in the 400 and thus became the second woman in USA history to qualify for the Olympics in the 100, 200, and 400. On NBC television she indicated it was only by the grace of God that she made the team having previously experienced a severe ankle injury.
